The MRC du Haut-Saint-François joins the programming of the 2023 edition of the Quebec Religious Heritage Days to be held in September. The MRC is proud to offer citizens and visitors the opportunity to discover 10 churches located across the territory of our MRC in the towns of Cookshire-Eaton and East Angus, the municipalities of Bury, La Patrie and Dudswell, and in the Township of Lingwick.

Each location offers mediation activities ranging from free visits, guided tour, conferences, concerts, exhibitions, and community activities.

These 10 churches of the circuit are a testimony to the exceptional heritage buildings present within our landscape. The churches are unravelling hidden treasures of historical, architectural, artistic, and cultural significance facilitated by personal encounters with members of the community who welcome visitors and transmit their passion for these places through proposed activities.
